S.R.O. No. 650/89.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968) and in supersession of the rules issued as per notification G.O. (P) No. 393/71 PD dated the 25th November, 1971 and published as S.R.O. No. 477/71 in the Kerala Gazette No. 48 dated the 14th December, 1971 and as per notification G.O. (P) No. 37/76/H.Edn. dated the 27th March, 1976 and published as S.R.O. No. 410/76 in the Kerala Gazette No. 15 dated the 13th April, 1976, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Special Rules for the posts in the Subordinate Service in the Department of Museums and Zoos including Sri Chitra Art Gallery, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Museum and Zoos (including Sri Chitra Art Gallery) Subordinate Service Special Rules, 1989.

6. *Qualification regard age:* No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment to any of the categories if he/she has not completed or will not complete 18 years of age or if he/she has completed or will complete 35 years of age on the 1st day of January of the year in which applications for appointment are invited, provided that a military pensioner shall be eligible for appointment as Sergeant if he has not completed 50 years age on the said date.

Note:—Usual relaxation of maximum age limit will be allowed to the applicants belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes.

7. *Other qualifications:*—No person shall be eligible for appointment to any of the categories in column (2) of the table below unless he/she possesses the qualifications prescribed in the corresponding entry in column (3) thereof.

Explanatory Note

(This is not part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Special Rules for the Kerala Museums and Zoos Subordinate Service were issued in G. O. (P) 37/76/H.Edn. dated 27-8-1976 and the Special Rules for Subordinate Service for Sri Chitra Art Gallery were issued as per G. O. (P) 393/71/PD dated 25-11-1971. Since then some new posts have been created and designations of certain posts have been changed. For some posts the qualifications prescribed have to be modified. Further it has been decided to issue Special Rules for the Department of Museums and Zoos in such a manner that Sri Chitra Art Gallery, Trivandrum will form an integral part of the Department of Museums and Zoos. It has therefore, become necessary to issue revised Special Rules for the various posts in the Subordinate Service of the Department of Museums and Zoos including the Sri Chitra Art Gallery, Trivandrum in supersession of all the rules and orders so far issued. This notification is intended to achieve the above objective.
